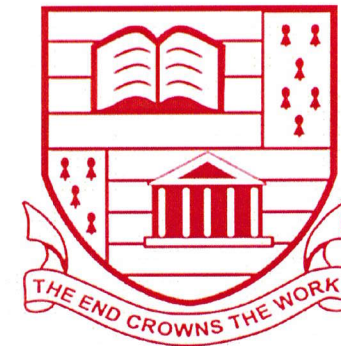

THE ARTS, NATURAL & SOCIAL SCIENCES FACULTY COLLABORATES WITH THE CARIBBEAN EXAMINATIONS COUNCIL (CXC) IN OFFERING A NUMBER OF CARIBBEAN ADVANCED PROFICIENCY EXAMINATION (CAPE) ASSOCIATE DEGREES.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR CAPE COURSES APPLICANTS SHOULD SATISFY UWI'S LOWER LEVEL MATRICULATION I.E., AT LEAST 5 CXCS GEN. I, II OR GCE O' LEVELS, A, B, INCLUDING ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND ONE OF THE FOLLOWING: A FOREIGN LANGUAGE, MATHEMATICS, AN APPROVED SCIENCE SUBJECT, OR GEOGRAPHY.

NB. 5 CXCS GEN. I, II., OR GCE O' LEVELS, A, B FOR THE SUBJECTS TO BE DONE AT THE CAPE LEVEL.

CANDIDATES WISHING TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION TO UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES AT UWI SHOULD NOTE THAT:

FOR THE FACULTY OF PURE & APPLIED SCIENCES: MATHEMATICS AND 2 APPROVED SCIENCE SUBJECTS ARE REQUIRED.

FOR THE FACULTY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES: MATHEMATICS AT THE CXC/GCE O' LEVEL IS REQUIRED.

CANDIDATES WHO DO NOT POSSESS A GRADE 1 IN CXC ENGLISH A, A GRADE A IN GCE O' LEVEL, A GRADE 1 OR 2 IN CAPE COMMUNICATION STUDIES, OR A GRADE A IN GENERAL PAPER, ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE AN ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY TEST ON ENTRY.
